

2021-2022 JAM Ballet Ensemble Information

We are so excited you are interested in joining our JAM Dance Company Ballet Ensemble for the 2020-2021 year. Below you will find important information. Ballet Ensemble is a Performance Line dedicated to promoting Ballet in the community. We will dance at various venues including the Tampa Veterans Home, Novemberfest, and the Strawberry Festival. This year, Ballet Ensemble will be dancing excerpts from Beauty and the Beast!

How do I become a Dance Company Ballet Ensemble member?

- You must be at least 7 years of age by January 1, 2021 and currently enrolled in a Ballet class.
- You must audition.
- You must be current with your dance account. No exceptions.
- You should attend Summer Ballet classes at Judy's Dance Academy.
- You must attend all technique and choreography classes regularly throughout the entire dance year.
- You must be available on weekends for Classes, Rehearsals and Performances in the community.

1 Ballet Class (2 classes is strongly encouraged)

1 Additional Technique class (examples: Contemporary, Jazz, Conditioning class)

Ballet Ensemble Cost

Ballet Ensemble is an additional financial commitment. **There are several costs associated that will be in addition to your class tuition.** Ballet Ensemble will also need a Travel costume, tan jazz shoes and tan tights for community performances. In addition, a Recital Costume will be required for our presentation of Beauty and the Beast in June.

COMPANY DEPOSITS: To secure your spot on the team, the Travel Costume must be paid by Sept. 30th so costumes can be ordered in time for our first Performance. **Costumes will not be ordered without payment, no exceptions.**
